Everybody Dance LA! transforms lives and communities through the power of high-quality dance education in low-income areas of Los Angeles. The In-School Program provides comprehensive, standards-based dance education that improves students' physical fitness, strengthens creative expression, and can include classroom theme integration. We tailor our program to fit the needs of each school we work with.

The **Everybody Dance LA!** In-School Program provides:

- 55-minute classes of high-quality dance education. Class times can be shortened.
- Flexibility scheduling
- Dance styles: creative movement, ballet, jazz, hip hop, breaking, Latin styles, Bollywood and more
- Teaching artists trained in classroom management, equity, diversity, access and inclusion practices, social, emotional, learning practices and best practices in dance education. They have undergone a background check through the DOJ with up-to-date TB tests
- Substitute Teaching Artists when needed
- Optional end-of-semester dance performances for each class
- A participation grade for each student, upon school's request
- MOU outlining our partnership and invoicing structure

What our school partners provide:

- · A teacher, aide, or school staff member in the room with dance teacher
- An administrative point person for regular communication with the In-School Program Manager
- A clean, indoor, dedicated space for dance classes
- A reliable sound system (one can be provided by Everybody Dance LA! for a fee if discussed in advance)
- Maximum of 30 students per dance class (large class sizes can be possible if discussed in advance)
- Our low cost of our program is subsidized through our grants and fundraising.
- We ask to participate in Back to School nights, coffee with Principals, or other family outreach events to become connected with the school community and share information about our low-cost afterschool program.
